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Solution for DU LLB Entrance Exam 2017

1. B

Spurred by the Unnikrishnan judgment and a public demand to enforce the right to education, successive governments from 1993 worked towards bringing a constitutional amendment to make education a fundamental right. That led to the 86th amendment in December 2002 which inserted the article 21A in the Constitution:

Right to education (21A):- The State shall provide free and compulsory education to all children of the age of six to fourteen years in such manner as the State may, by law, determine."

2. B

Article 80 of the Constitution lays down the maximum strength of Rajya Sabha as 250, out of which 12 members are nominated by the President and 238 are representatives of the States and of the two Union Territories.

3. B

To make sure that Rajya Sabha doesn't amend the bill by adding some non-money matters (known as Financial Bill), the Lok Sabha Speaker certifies the bill as a money bill before sending it to the upper house, and the decision of the Speaker is binding on both the Houses.

4. C

Carbon footprint is the amount of carbon dioxide released into the atmosphere as a result of the activities of a particular individual, organization, or community.

6. B

The Leader of the Opposition is the politician who leads the official opposition in either House of the Parliament of India. The post received statutory recognition through the Salary and Allowances of Leaders of Opposition in Parliament Act, 1977 which defines the term "Leader of the Opposition" as that member of the Lok Sabha or the Rajya Sabha who, for the time being, is the Leader of that House of the Party in Opposition to the Government having the greatest numerical strength and recognised, as such, by the Chairman of the Rajya Sabha or the Speaker of the Lok Sabha. As in the given question Alphabet "L" and "O" are given in capital that could mean that the question is referring to recognized opposition leader and thus the answer would be C i.e. Y. B. Chavan.

The second possibility is the opposition leader of 1st lok sabha was A. K. Gopalan, until then the post of opposition of leader was not recognized.



The third possibility could be option B, as in 4th Lok Sabha election the Indian National Congress (INC) satisfied the criteria of 10% of vote and thus Dr. Ram Suhag Singh is elected as the Opposition leader.

The act defines a child as any person below the age of 18 years and provides protection to all children under the age of 18 years from the offences of sexual assault, sexual harassment and pornography.

The word Quo-Warranto literally means "by what warrants?" or "what is your authority"? It is a writ issued with a view to restrain a person from holding a public office to which he is not entitled. The writ requires the concerned person to explain to the Court by what authority he holds the office. If a person has usurped a public office, the Court may direct him not to carry out any activities in the office or may announce the office to be vacant. Thus High Court may issue a writ of quo-warranto if a person holds an office beyond his retirement age.

Similarly, Sohan can finish the work in 40 days, so his per day work is 3 units.

Working together the work done per day by Sohan and Ram = 2 + 3 = 5 units

To complete 120 units of work they together take $120/5 = 24$ days.

Let's consider the cost price for Geeta be 'x'.

as given in the question,

$$(80 \times x) / 100 = 800$$

$$x = 1000$$

The cost price for Geeta would be the selling price for Shakti.



Let's consider the actual price of watch be 'w'

$$(80 * w)/100 = 1000$$

$$w=1250$$

Thus the actual cost of the watch is Rs. 1,250.

88. B

As given in the question,

$$\text{Speed} = 60 \text{ km/hr} = 50/3 \text{ m/sec}$$

$$\text{Time} = 120 \text{ sec}$$

$$\text{Distance} = L_1 + L_2 = 800 + x$$

Using the formula, $\text{Speed} = \text{Distance} / \text{Time}$

$$50/3 = (800 + x) / 120$$

$$2000 = 800 + x$$

$$\text{Therefore, } x = 1200$$

The length of the bridge is 1200 meters.

89. D

Let's consider the price of both pens were 'x' and 'y'.

As given in the question

$$x + y = 65 \dots (1)$$

$$x + y = (107 * x) / 100 + (94 * y) / 100$$

$$6500 = 107x + 94(65 - x)$$

$$6500 = 107x + 94 * 65 - 94x$$

$$6500 = 6110 + 13x$$

$$390 = 13x$$

$$x = 30$$

$$y = 65 - 30 = 35$$

Therefore, the cost of the two pens are 30 and 35.
